Title I: Title I of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990

Title II: Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990

Prohibits discrimination, exclusion from participation, and denial of benefits on the basis of disability in the areas of educational programming and activities. (Coordinator: Dr. Anne Wilson, Superintendent, Sudbury Public Schools, 40 Fairbank Road, Sudbury, MA 01776 – Telephone 978-639-3211)

Title VI: Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964

Prohibits discrimination, exclusion from participation, and denial of benefits based on race, color and national origin. (Coordinator: Dr. Anne Wilson, Superintendent, Sudbury Public Schools, 40 Fairbank Road, Sudbury, MA 01776 – Telephone 978-639-3211)

Title IX: Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972

Section 504: Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973

Prohibits discrimination, exclusion from participation, and denial of benefits based on disability. (Coordinator: Ms. Deborah Dixon, Superintendent, Sudbury Public Schools, 40 Fairbank Road, Sudbury, MA 01776 – Telephone: 978-639-3202)

MGL. Ch. 76, s5: Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 76 Section 5

Prohibits discrimination in all public schools on the basis of race, color, sex, national origin, religion, gender identity, and sexual orientation. (Coordinator:: Dr. Anne Wilson, Superintendent, Sudbury Public Schools, 40 Fairbank Road, Sudbury, MA 01776 – Telephone: 978-639-3211)

EEOA: The Equal Educational Opportunities Act of 1974

FERPA: The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974

IDEA 2004: The Individuals with Disabilities Education Act of 2004

M.G.L.c.71A: Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 71A

Governs the education of English learners. (Coordinator: Ms. Kimberly Swain, Assistant Superintendent, Sudbury Public Schools, 40 Fairbank Road, Sudbury, MA 01776 – Telephone: 978-639-3216).

M.G.L.c. 71B: Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 71B

NCLB: The No Child Left Behind Act of 2001, Title X, Part C
