

SMART GOALS – SUDBURY SCHOOL COMMITTEE 2018-2019

(In No Order of Priority)

1. The Sudbury School Committee (SSC) will adopt a new District Policy Manual. The Committee will schedule necessary meetings to complete review of the Draft District Policy. School Committee members will comment and make suggested changes to the Draft District Policy. Upon completion of review of the Draft District Policy Manual, SSC will vote on adoption of the District Policy Manual by October 29, 2018. SSC will determine future goals and objectives for the Policy Subcommittee.
2. The Sudbury School Committee (SSC) will work collaboratively with Town leadership to assess options for the relocation of Sudbury Public School Administrative Offices. The Committee will form a subcommittee, in collaboration with the Administration to make a final recommendation. Upon completion, the SSC will make its recommendation to the Board of Selectmen and/the Town of Sudbury by June 30, 2019.
3. The Sudbury School Committee (SSC) will work to assess and assure equity and consistency across the District. The Committee will work in collaboration with the Superintendent to define equity in education. The Committee will then will review its policies to make sure they meet equity expectations. The SSC will conduct such assessments by meetings and discussions with the Superintendent. The SSC will make any and all recommendations by June 30, 2019.
4. The Sudbury School Committee (SSC) will work collaboratively with the Administration to formulate a District-Wide Strategic Plan. The strategic plan will define District goals established jointly by the Administration and the School Committee. The Committee will form a subcommittee in furtherance of development of the Strategic Plan. The subcommittee will make recommendations to the full School Committee by June 30, 2019.
